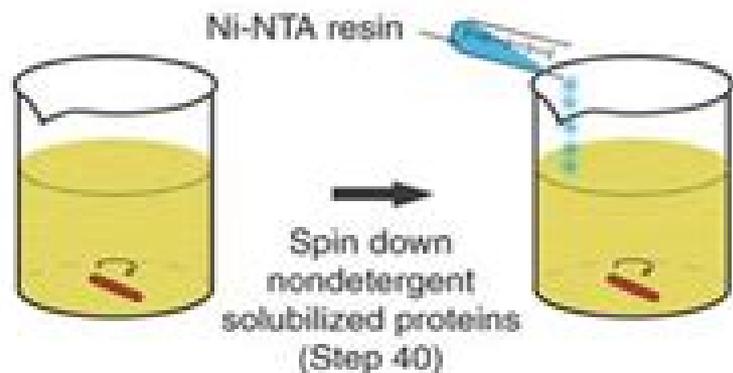
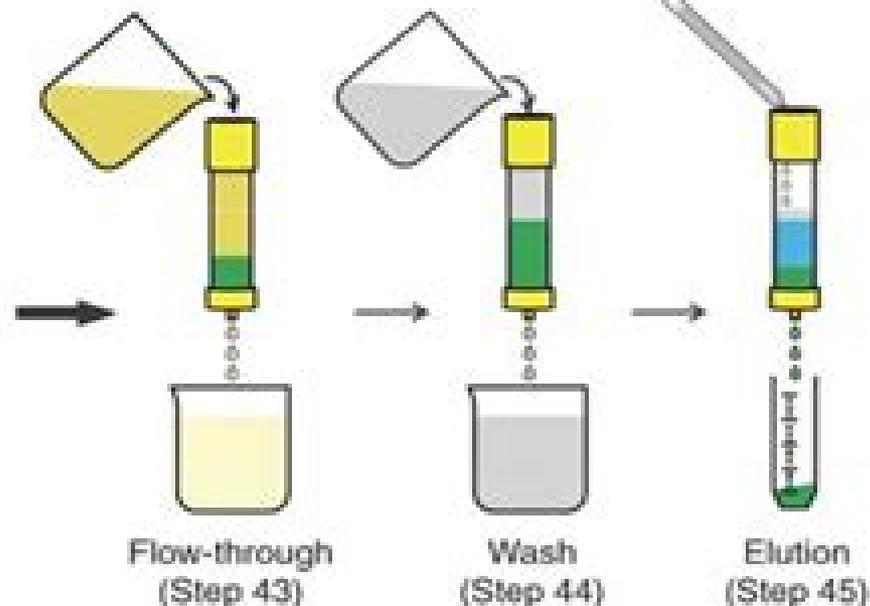


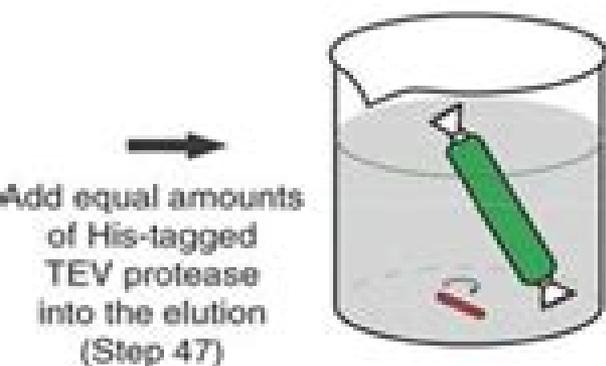
a Detergent-solubilization of membrane protein GFP-fusion (Step 39)



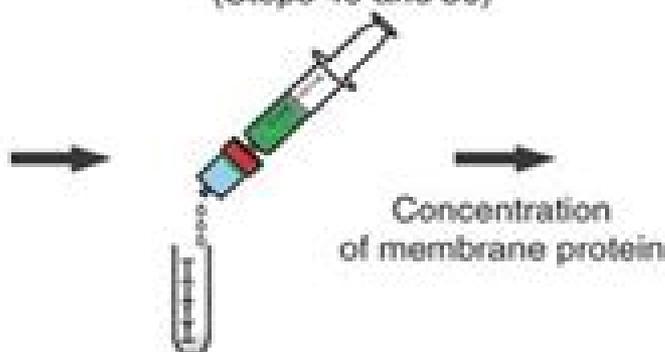
b Incubation of supernatant with Ni-NTA resin (Step 42)



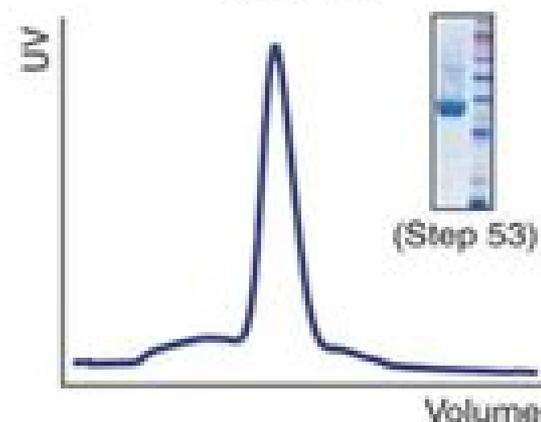
d Dialysis and cleavage of GFP-8His from membrane protein-GFP fusion (Step 47)
