Shifting from strategic to tactical concerns the author explains how the Marines on Guadalcanal despite inadequate logistical support and horrendous living conditions managed to prevail in the Americans first ground campaign of World War II an achievement of such magnitude as to make Japan's ultimate defeat in the war inevitable.

British and Japanese Military Leadership in the Far Eastern War, 1941-1945 Brian Bond, Kyoichi Tachikawa, 2004.
