Example: Student who is weighed on scale.

- 1. Reliability: consistency of a measure.
- 2. Validity: does a measure truly assess quality that it's claimed to measure? Truthfulness of a measure.

3. Accuracy: Agreement with a known standard (process of calibration).

3. Possible limits of "free choice"  
B. Science makes systematic observations  
- Scientists' systematic observations include:  
a. precise definitions of phenomena being observed  
b. reliable + valid measuring tools that yield useful + interpretable data.  
c. generally accepted method/obcs  
d. System of logic for drawing conclusions and fitting those into general theories.

C. Science Produces Public Knowledge.  
- An objective observation is someone who is completely objective (like Peirce thought). It just means something that can be verified by more than 1 observer.

- Done through replication where someone redoes another's study and gets same results.  
- Replication can only be done if they know precisely what was done. This is done by rules that are found in Publication Manual of APA.

- Introspection: a form of precise self-report.  
- The problem w/ introspect is that its subjective and not verifiable.  
- John B. Watson concluded that something can only be "scientific" if its directly observable and can be verified.  
- Watson felt behavior was the key for this. So he became the founder of behaviorism.  
- Now we observe behavior instead of introspect.

D. Science produces Data-Based Conclusions -  
- Scientists are data-driven  
- Conclusions about behavior need to be supported by some evidence.
