Theatre Royal Covent Garden forerunner of the Royal Opera House In 1920 The Beggar s Opera began an astonishing revival run of 1 463 performances at the Lyric Theatre in Hammersmith London which was one of the longest runs in history for any piece of musical theatre at that time The piece satirised Italian opera which had become popular in London According to The New York Times Gay wrote the work more as an anti opera than an opera one of its attractions to its 18th century London public being its lampooning of the Italian opera style and the English public s fascination with it Instead of the grand music and themes of opera the work uses familiar tunes and characters that were ordinary **“The” Operas of Benjamin**
