**The Modern Crisis** Murray Bookchin, 2022-07-29 Murray Bookchin's frank assessment of the disaster we are heading toward at increasing speed is as much a work of ethics as it is of environmentalism. The four essays that comprise it share the view that as he puts it, our ideas and our practice must be imbued with a deep sense of ethical commitment. Bookchin's social ecology refuses to separate society from nature. As such, one can consider it a philosophy of participation; we cannot develop ecocommunities that aren't participatory. We can't save ourselves and the planet without an ethics of freedom.
