OVERVIEW

Marxism and Morality Nicholas Churchich, 1994 Not himself a Marxist Dr Churchich has nevertheless won plaudits for this book from those committed to the philosophy It is they acknowledge thoroughly researched well reasoned and balanced in its argument even if that argument is one with which Marxists are bound to disagree being based on the premise that ethical theories must ultimately rest on metaphysical and psychological preconceptions rather than on some imaginary empirical facts The declared aim of this work is to present a full exposition of Marx's and Engels' ideas on morality and ethics and to indicate some of their errors and weaknesses Unlike other studies of this subject Churchich analyses all major aspects of morality dealing not only with the writings of Marx himself but also with the works of most writers who have commented on Marxist morality and ethics Marx himself intended to produce a work on social morality but did not manage to do so This book will therefore and without doubt become the standard work on his view of the subject Superior to anything else on the topic written by non Marxists it is clearer on some aspects of Marx's view than the work of some Marxist writers Churchich makes obvious for instance how great was Althusser's mistake in arguing that there is not a grain of normative ethics in mature Marx Yet the author's objectivity allows him also to find values among the ethical arguments of Marx and Engels making this a book which both Marxists and concerned Anglicans would find useful as a criticism of some current social trends It also

sounds a cautionary note for those who argue that the collapse of bureaucratic socialism in the former Soviet Union means the end of Marxism too this is by no means Dr Churchich s view

The Psychological Basis of Moral Judgments John Park,2021-07-18 This volume examines the psychological basis of moral judgments and asks what theories of concepts apply to moral concepts By combining philosophical reasoning and empirical insights from the fields of moral psychology cognitive science evolutionary psychology and neuroscience it considers what mental states not only influence but also constitute our moral concepts and judgments On this basis Park proposes a novel pluralistic theory of moral concepts which includes three different cognitive structures and emotions Thus our moral judgments are shown to be a hybrid that express both cognitive and conative states In part through analysis of new empirical data on moral semantic intuitions gathered via cross cultural experimental research Park reveals that the referents of individuals moral judgments and concepts vary across time contexts and groups On this basis he contends for moral relativism where moral judgments cannot be universally true across time and location but only relative to groups This powerfully argued text will be of interest to researchers academics and educators with an interest in cognitive science moral theory philosophy of psychology and moral psychology more broadly Those interested in ethics applied social psychology and moral development will also benefit from the volume

Metaphysics of Morality Christopher B.
