

the book which was to be devoted to instruments in combination But I soon realised that I had gone too far With wind instruments in particular the different systems were innumerable and each manufacturer favoured his own pet theory By the addition of a certain key the maker endowed his instrument with the possibility of a new trill and VIII made some difficult passages more playable than on an instrument of another kind
