- Prolog is a logic programming language based on rules and facts.
- Unlike procedural languages (e.g., C++ or Python), Prolog programs define *what* needs to be solved rather than *how* to solve it.
- It is excellent for problems involving **relationships**,
- **pattern matching**, and **logical reasoning**.
- Example: she has doll set
- Two boys have brothers if both are male and they have same parents.
