

Postabortion care in Latin America: policy and service recommendations from a decade of operations research

Unsafe abortion contributes significantly to maternal mortality and morbidity in Latin America. Postabortion care (PAC) using preferred technologies and a woman-centred approach to treat the complications of unsafe abortion can save women's lives and improve their reproductive health, as well as reduce costs to health systems. This article reviews results from 10 major PAC operations research projects conducted in public sector hospitals in seven Latin American countries, completed and published between 1991 and 2002. The studies show that following relatively modest interventions, the majority of eligible patients were being treated with manual vacuum aspiration (MVA), a method preferred for safety and other reasons over the method conventionally used in the region, sharp curettage (SC). A number of studies showed improvements in contraceptive counselling and services when these were integrated with clinical treatment of abortion complications, resulting in substantial increases in contraceptive acceptance. Finally, data from several studies showed that, in most settings, reorganizing services by moving treatment out of the operating theatre and reclassifying treatment as an ambulatory care procedure substantially reduced the resources used for PAC, as well as the cost and average length of women's stay in the hospital. These studies suggest that comprehensive PAC can and should be available to all women in Latin America. Such efforts should be coupled with work to improve primary prevention, including better contraceptive services to prevent unwanted pregnancy and safe, legal abortion services to reduce the number of clandestine and unsafe abortions.

Introduction

Unsafe abortion, defined as a procedure for terminating an unintended pregnancy either by persons lacking the necessary skills or in an environment lacking the minimal medical standards, or both, poses significant risks to women's health and lives (WHO 2003). Throughout Latin America and the Caribbean, abortion laws are restrictive, and clandestine, often unsafe, abortion is common. Notable exceptions are Cuba and Guyana where abortion is legal for a wide range of indications. An estimated 3.7 million unsafe abortions take place each year in the region, with an abortion rate of 29 per 1000 women of reproductive age or almost one unsafe abortion to every three live births (WHO 2002). WHO (2004) estimates that 15% of unsafe abortions are among women aged 15 to 19, 29% among women aged 20 to 24, and 56% among women aged 25 to 49. In the region approximately 3700 women die each year from unsafe abortion. For every death, many more women experience injuries and disabilities requiring emergency medical treatment. Most mortality and morbidity figures are underestimates since they tend to exclude women who do not utilize formal public health services. In addition, many abortions go unreported even within public sector health services.

Yet mortality and morbidity resulting from unsafe abortion are preventable. Safe surgical and medical approaches to induce abortion are highly effective and present little risk to women (Grimes 1997; Dudley 2000; WHO 2004). However, where women do not have access to safe induced abortions, prompt

postabortion care (PAC) can at least save their lives and afford them opportunities to prevent unintended pregnancies in the future through contraceptive counselling and services. At the 1994 International Conference on Population and Development (ICPD), governments endorsed PAC as an essential response to the public health problem of unsafe abortion. A PAC model developed by Ipas, an international reproductive health organization, was subsequently introduced by civil society organizations and national health systems in developing countries, often with significant funding from donors such as the U.S. Agency for International Development, the British Department for International Development, and various private foundations (Greenlade et al. 1994; Corbett and Turner 2003). The three main components are:

- (1) *Prompt treatment of complications from unsafe (or spontaneous) abortion that are potentially life-threatening, using manual vacuum aspiration (MVA) or other preferred methods;*
- (2) *Offering contraceptive counselling and methods to help women achieve their reproductive intentions and avoid repeat abortions;*
- (3) *Offering on-site, or through referral, other reproductive health services needed by women experiencing abortion complications.*

A recent revision of the PAC model makes explicit two additional elements that render PAC services more effective in meeting women's needs: *general counselling to identify and respond to women's emotional and physical health*
