- It is a post-positivist approach to IR that rejects the theoretical revolution as the basis for understanding the international system.
- It is defined as incredulity (disbelief) towards metanarratives (any story told to justify another story) (Lyotard, 1984).
- A multi-faceted theoretical approach which challenges the certainties and dualisms of modernism but promotes pluralism (Garner *et al*, 2009).
- It is powered by Michael Foucault & Jacques Derrida.
