

Prehistoric clothing

There are no exact certainties as to when the human being started wearing clothes. The anthropologists estimate that it started about 100,000 and 500,000 years ago. The first garments were made of skins and animal leather, herbs and bones, or bones and shells. This is why there are very scarce remains of them which were preserved. Simple needles made of bone are evidence that leather clothes were seen at least 30,000 years ago.

Looking for warming

About 100,000 years ago, the human had probably learned to wear clothes to face the very low temperatures of the glaciations. They learned to sew leather and also were the possessors in the use of some kind of clothing. The man of Cro-Magnon, the direct predecessor of modern humans 30,000 years ago, started using bone elements to manufacture some clothes, more elaborated throughout time. He created the needles and sewing machines, with which he covered the entire body. He also knew advanced techniques through the incorporation of the wool and it discovered the fibres with which he manufactured the first fabrics.

Garment fabrics

The prehistoric man developed different methods to treat animal hides, a process known as tanning, creating in this way garments that were soft and pliable and also easy to wear. Later, animal skins were being used to make shoes. Preparation of wool got to include processes for its preservation and, also, its decoration.

Prehistoric garments
Prehistoric garments were made mainly with animal skins, mostly of deer and that were decorated.



Between skins and leather

During the Neolithic era, between the 10,000 and 8,000 BC, the weather started changing and becoming less cold. The human kept wearing clothes of animal leather and skins, although less rudimentary than that of its predecessors, thanks to the fact that tools had reached a significant development.

Complete ensemble
Some ensembles of about 10,000 years ago were made of animal skins and deer hair, woven and sewn with flax.

Long and clothes
The clothing was probably woven from flax which obtained from various 10,000 years ago with the wool obtained from the human being already used before that.


Woolen fabric
Wool of deer and sometimes goat was used as the raw material to make garments. It is probably that animal skins.

A refinement of the wool was generated through the use of sheep, goats, alpacas and vicuñas with their own wool.

Decorative
Woolen and decorated garments were made. The people that manufactured them used animal skins and deer with raw wool.

The woolen fabric was made from the wool of sheep, goats, alpacas and vicuñas. It was used to make the entire body of the garment.
